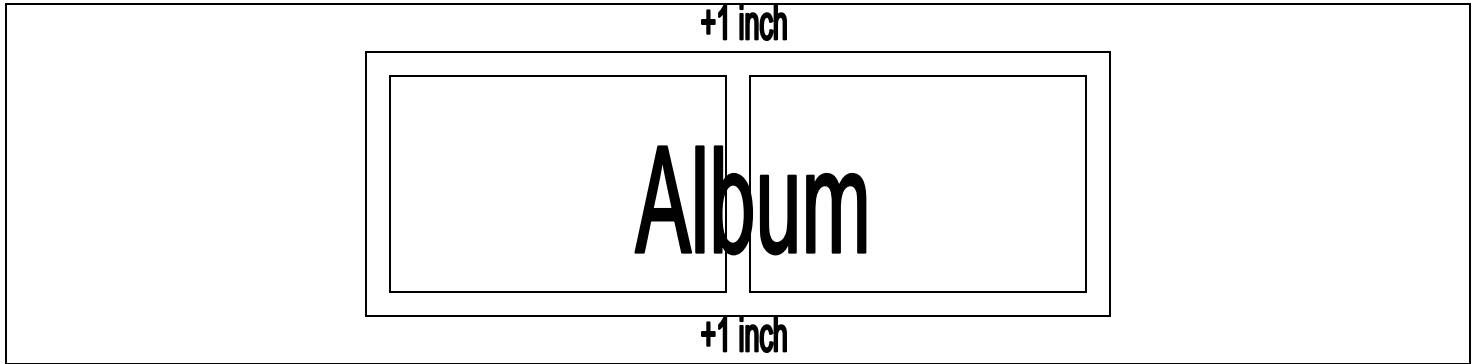
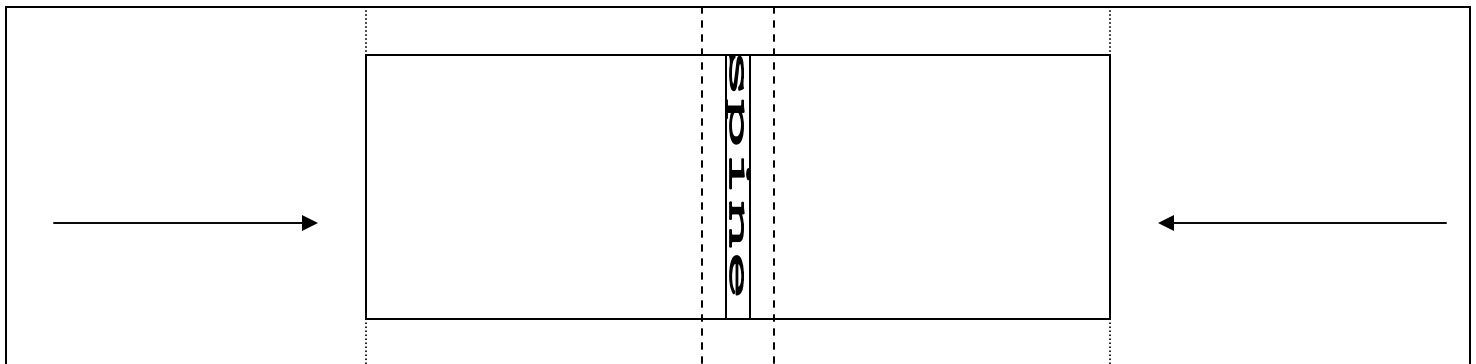


# Covering an Album

1. Lay out fabric face up and album with pages facing up. Make sure any post extensions the finished album will need are in now. Cut the fabric so that there is an extra inch on the top and bottom.



2. Fold the edges toward the center, all the way to the spine, plus a half inch or so for hemming the edges. Hem the edges.



3. You should have something that looks like this. Along the top and bottom edges, mark a pencil line about 1/2" from the album. This will give you plenty of room to slip the covers in. At this point, you should be marking the back side of the fabric. Pin it and sew along that line. Once you've sewn the 4 lines, turn the cover right side out and slide the cover on. You may have to trim some of the excess fabric from the seams to make it fit smoothly. Embellish!!!
